

## TEACHING APPOINTMENTS: SALARY TABLE, 2013-14

The four types of teaching appointments are presented hierarchically to reflect increasing degrees of responsibility. The tables below list the minimum rates for all percentages of time from 50% to 10%. The University has not established a maximum salary for graduate teaching assistants.

Appointments of less than 10% are not allowed. Assistantship appointments must be made in increments of 5%. A 40% appointment must be combined with a 10% appointment.

45 % appointments are not allowed.

During the Summer Quarter, if a student is appointed to teach a class which will be shorter than the standard 12-week quarter, you can enter an "end date" on the student's assistantship pay line in GFS. This will pay the student at the same per-pay period rate, but will shorten the period of time for which the student is paid. This should be done only in the Summer Quarter, in the case of classes that are less than a normal quarter's length.

Dollars shown match the quarterly totals and per-pay-period amounts calculated in GFS
